At Sharjah Public School, we implement an Acceptable Use Policy for students to ensure that everyone feels safe at all times. Keeping you safe while using your devices and the internet—whether at home or school—is important, and these rules will help protect you and others.

Acceptable Internet Use Policy – Students

1. Personal Safety:

- ✓ Be aware that your use of school technology (internet network or devices) is monitored by administrators.
- ✓ Ensure proper use of school technology and take care of electronic devices.
- ✓ Use the school internet network and technology for educational purposes only.
- ✓ Keep your personal username and password confidential and do not share them with anyone.
- ✓ Do not share personal information online or via email.
- ✓ Make sure to inform a trusted adult (parents, teacher, or supervisor) if you feel uncomfortable or upset about anything online or on social media.

2. School and Others' Safety:

- ✓ Students are prohibited from using other students'

accounts.

✓ Do not view, send, download, or publish any offensive or inappropriate material that violates the country's laws or the school's policies, or contradicts Islamic ethics and teachings.

✓ Always use appropriate and polite language in all digital communications, including emails, social networks, websites, chats, or messages.

✓ Do not copy others' work and claim it as your own.

✓ Any behavior that violates the Code of Conduct, such as bullying, is strictly prohibited.

✓ You must report any violations or bullying incidents among students.

✓ It is prohibited to take photos or record teachers without permission, as this will subject you to legal accountability.

✓ Bringing a mobile phone to school is strictly prohibited and will be monitored through the school's surveillance cameras.
